2. Personal Paraphrase

Write out each verse or section of verses in your own words.

3. Questions and Answers

Write down as many questions as you can and attempt to answer them.

4. Cross Reference

Make note of any similar or related passages that come to mind while you're reading, and read those similar passages.

5. Insights

If you observe something that relates to any part of the passage, write it down. After completing your own thoughts and analysis, consult a Bible commentary.

6. Application

How will you apply this to your life?

7. Title and Summarize

After completing your analysis of the chapter, give it a title and identify a key verse or verses. Write a summary paragraph outlining the chapter's thesis.
