





God's Riches at Christ's Expense



There was a New York Times article that Pastor Jay Jarman brought to my attention. "The Uncommon Power of Grace" by Peter Wehner, in which Mr. Wehner writes:

Philip Yancey, in his book "What's So Amazing About Grace?," describes a conference on comparative religions where experts from around the world debated which belief, if any, was unique to the Christian faith. C.S. Lewis happened to enter the room during the discussion. When he was told the topic was Christianity's unique contribution among world religions, Lewis responded: "Oh, that's easy. It's grace."

Yes, it's that easy! One popular definition of God's saving grace is this: Getting what we don't deserve. Here's a passage out of Romans 5:15 that gives us hope in the truth of this:

But the gift of God's undeserved grace was very different from Adam's sin. That one sin brought death to many others. Yet in an even greater way, Jesus Christ alone brought God's gift of undeserved grace to many people.

God gave it all so that we could have the gift of grace -- His son Jesus. We don't deserve Jesus. We can't earn Jesus. We can't ever pay Him back. All we can do is receive Jesus ... the gift of grace ... with gratitude and understanding of how much it cost for Him to go to the cross for you and me. That's it. Nothing more.

Did you notice that acronym at the start of this article? God's Riches At Christ's Expense. That's GRACE! That's JESUS!

For those who have received His gift of grace, we must go and live a grace-filled life towards others. We don't do this out of compulsion. We do so because we have surrendered hearts to the grace of God.

No Parking-Dialysis Center


Please note that the Dialysis Center and the Kaimuki Busness Plaza will not be available for parking on Sunday, Dec. 30st.
